




EPOS TCS ANTHROPOGENIC HAZARDS Consortium



- Integrates sustainable research infrastructures that facilitate and stimulate studies on anthropogenic hazards with science-industry collaboration and stakeholder knowledge exchange within EPOS.
- EPOS TCS AH Consortium consists of 14 European members and 1 associate member from Brasil. It gathers academic and scientific institutions, research centers, and industry and private organizations.
- Research on anthropogenic hazards requires an interdisciplinary approach. The ANTHROPOGENIC HAZARDS TCS coordinates the integration and access to facilities, datasets, and scientific products on anthropogenic hazards. Cooperating with worldwide institutions within the EPOS framework, the ANTHROPOGENIC HAZARDS TCS provides open data, software, and processing capacity on the EPISODES Platform to foster research and training on induced seismicity and hazards related to the exploration and exploitation of georesources.
